Additional script modifications were made to enhance the cohesion of the story, and the role of fictitious CIA operative Mitch Jackelson, played by Mycole Thon, was expanded and refined to embody the theme of "Patriots and Conspirators."

This series will highlight controversial characters—both real and fictional--and their roles in popular conspiracy theories. For example, Mycole Thon's character, a CIA "jackel," or assassin, embodies the emotional conflicts and moral dilemmas one faces when doing one's patriotic duty requires extreme actions, seemingly going against acceptable moral standards, or possibly conspiratorial when viewed in light of the Constitution, yet actions that seem like the right thing to do, depending on the viewpoint.
